### **Craft Time = Potato prints!**

You can use potatoes, carrots, onions, apples, celery - whatever you've got in your pantry. What shapes and textures do the different fruits & vegetables make?

Cut the potatoes into shapes or use the potato as is -



You can create pictures with the shapes, or make a pattern. I used tempera paint, but you can also use a stamp pad if you don't want to bring out the paint.

Make a forest with a triangle shape!
